



## Robert LaFleur

November 4, 1952 - December 12, 2021

Robert Philip “Bob” LaFleur passed away unexpectedly at age 69 on Sunday, December 12, 2021, at Elliot Hospital in Manchester. Bob was a 26-year resident of Litchfield, NH. He fought a multi-year battle with diabetes, kidney failure, and heart problems.

Bob was born in Kokomo, Indiana on November 4, 1952, to Philip and Lorraine (Duford) LaFleur. He grew up in Indiana, Hooksett, NH, and Levittown, PA. He was a dual graduate of Bishop Egan High School and Bucks County Technical School in Fairless Hills, PA in 1970.

Bob followed in the family trade as a Printing Pressman. He spent his life maintaining and operating machinery that produced printed documents on a large scale. In 1995, he relocated his family to New Hampshire where he resided for the remainder of his life. Always fascinated with aircraft and space travel he seemed to live with his gaze upwards, and spent time volunteering at the Aviation Museum of New Hampshire. He gained his private pilot’s license and enjoyed flying small aircraft. Bob enjoyed rooting for the Boston Red Sox at every possible opportunity. Though he was not able to serve in the military, despite multiple attempts, he nevertheless always felt a deep sense of patriotism and pride for his home. Bob also enjoyed golfing and bowling with family and friends. He also enjoyed dressing up and playing Santa at Christmas for friends and family. His warm smile and signature laugh will be

missed by those who knew him.

Bob is survived by his beloved wife of 45 years, Noreen (Mulligan) LaFleur, his children, Christopher LaFleur (and wife Jessica), John LaFleur (and wife Callie) of Litchfield, NH, and Rachel LaFleur (and husband Jordan) of Shoreline, WA. Bob's grandchildren, Evelyn LaFleur and Marion LaFleur will miss their beloved P p re. He leaves siblings Janine Penfield (and husband Robert) of Concord, MA, Joseph LaFleur (and wife Cathy) of Penacook, NH, Mary Tyrrell (and husband Joel) and Michelle LaFleur, both of Levittown, PA, along with many nieces and nephews, and cousins.
