For many dedicated years, from the age of 19 until he retired, he was a well-known scientific glassblower.

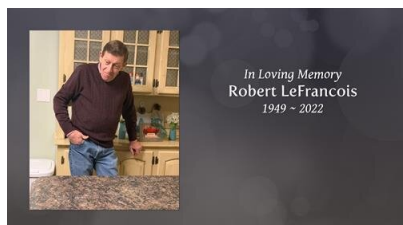
