

Robert Moncada Sr.

September 7, 1938 - April 7, 2021

On April 7, 2021, Robert Timothy Moncada Sr., beloved husband, father of seven, grandfather of twelve, and great grandfather of five, passed away at the age of 82.

Bob was born in Middletown, Connecticut on September 7, 1938, son of late Settimo and Mildred (Champagne) Moncada. One of four children, including his late brother Alan and sister Patricia, he is survived by his sister Susan.

With a desire to serve his country, he enlisted with the U.S. Army in 1956, was a paratrooper, and attained the rank of Engineer Sergeant with the Special Forces. He went on to marry the love of his life, Roberta (Piontek) in 1970, with whom he built a large family and thriving business, Nashua Circuits, which he ran with his partner Paul Linehan Jr. for 38 years.

Bob was a generous man, never missing an opportunity to help a friend in need or to support an employee. He had a great love of life and nature and was often off fishing at one of his favorite spots near his cabin on the Miramichi River in New Brunswick, his house in Nantucket, or during vacations in Key West. Wherever he traveled, he made life-long friends.

Bob had many loves, from lighthouses, to feeding birds, to playing acoustic guitar, but none could compare to his love for his family, including his children:

Robbie, Robin, Patty, Darcy, Erica, and Amber, his twelve grandchildren: Jessica, Brendon, Cameron, Remy, Adrienne, Shawna, Anna, Lauren, Ethan, Morgan, Sharissa, and Jacob and five great grandchildren: Kaiden, Aubree, Cole, John, and Henry. Bob was predeceased by his fourth child, Joseph Moncada.
