

Robert W. Woodward, Jr.

February 19, 1933 - August 14, 2022

Robert W. Woodward, Jr. passed away at his home of 62 years on Sunday August 14, 2022.

He was born February 19, 1933 in Kokomo, IN, the son of Robert W. Woodward, Sr and Gladys Irene Thompson. He was raised by his grandparents, Leroy and Anna Thompson and educated in Kokomo.

Robert was predeceased by his loving wife of 52 years Donna Colleen Woodward, a daughter-in-law, Lori Woodward and a granddaughter, Cassidy Woodward.

Robert, affectionately known as Woody or Grampa, served in the US Navy for four years being honorably discharged on September 28, 1956. Following his service, he attended Valparaiso Technical Institute and received an Associate Degree in Electrical Engineering. He moved his family to New Hampshire in 1961 to take a job at Sanders Associates/Lockheed/BAE Systems where he worked for 36 years. Over the years, he enjoyed playing tennis, golf, and fishing but mostly spending time with his family. Robert was a dad to more than his 6 kids and was referred to as Mr. Woody by many.

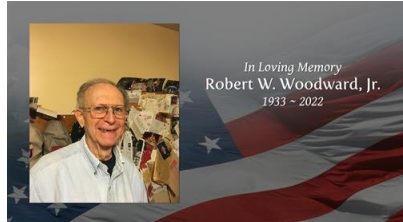
