Robert Gerard Rioux, 72, entered eternal rest on Wednesday, July 20, 2011 at the Community Hospice House, after a long and courageous battle with lung cancer. He was surrounded by his loving family.

Born in Clova, Quebec, Canada, he was one of twelve children born to Adrien and Eva (Morin) Rioux. He was predeceased by his parents and two of his brothers, Jean-Eve and Henri Rioux also of Quebec, Canada.
