Russell Gregory Curtis, 53, of Hudson, NH unexpectedly passed away on Sunday, January 15, 2023 at St. Joseph's Hospital in Nashua, NH.

Russell was born April 23, 1969, the second son of Carl G. and Sheila (Howland) Curtis. He was raised and educated in Hudson, where he remained a lifelong resident.

He was diagnosed at age 4 with type 1 diabetes, and after suffering complications of blindness and renal failure, he was the grateful recipient of a kidney, which he faithfully took care of for nearly 18 years. Despite health challenges over the years, he was an avid tea drinker and sports fan. Always favoring the Boston sports teams, Russ would often listen to the Bruins, Patriots, and Red Sox games. Just about everyone who met him will remember him sporting a Bruins or Red Sox cap, depending on the season.

Survivors include both of his parents, siblings Bryan and Carla, all from Hudson; great uncle Ronald Kinney of Connecticut; aunts and uncles Gary Curtis of Maine, Donna Curtis and Tom Pinkin of Connecticut, Richard and Celeste Curtis of Maine, Keith and Michelle Howland of New Hampshire, and Alan and Candy Howland of Virginia; cousins Christopher Curtis, Nathan Cardozo, Terra Curtis, Cassidy Holden, Garrett Curtis, Haley Holden, and Avery Curtis; Jeffery and Timothy Howland and Laura Howland-Carberry;

Heather and Christopher Jordan. He was predeceased by his grandparents Donald and Ida Curtis, Elmer and Alta Howland, and aunt and uncle Patricia (Curtis) and Gary Jordan.
