Scott Berton McLain, age 90, of Londonderry, New Hampshire, passed away peacefully at home on December 29, 2025.

Scott was born in Jefferson, New Hampshire, and proudly served his country in the United States Marine Corps. He spent most of his life as a dedicated resident of Hudson, New Hampshire, where he built both his career and his family.

Scott had a diverse and accomplished professional life. He was a high school teacher at Nashua High School, owned and operated Hudson Driving School for many years, worked as a sheet metal fabricator, and later contributed to the high-tech industry. He also worked in research and development at the MIT Nuclear Reactor Laboratory, reflecting his lifelong curiosity and commitment to learning.

Scott is survived by his beloved wife, Raelene, with whom he shared 68 years of marriage. He was a devoted father to his four children: Vicki and her husband Martin, Debbi and her husband Chris, Daniel and his partner Sharena, Scott and his partner Annette. He also leaves behind 13 grandchildren, 9 great-grandchildren.
