Sharon Kurowski, a long time resident of Hudson, NH died unexpectedly January 24, 2017 surrounded by her loving family. She was the wife of Robert Kurowski, with whom she had celebrated their 31st wedding anniversary this past June.

Sharon was born December 11, 1953 in Lowell, MA the daughter of the late Roger Montbleau and Florence (Montbleau) Sargent and her husband Charles Sargent of Derry, NH.

Sharon attended the Lowell, MA school system. She was a dedicated social worker for the Commonwealth of Massachusetts Welfare Department in Lowell, where she worked for 27 years. She will be remembered by friends and family for her endless love and devotion to her 14 grandchildren.
