Sin Fai Chan, 90 of Nashua, died Friday July 4, 2014 at St. Joseph Hospital in Nashua with his loving family by his side.

He was born August 23, 1923 in China, son of the late Yuk Cheung Chan and Kew (Lam) Chan. He was also predeceased by his daughter, Wan Choi Chan.

Sin was the husband of Ngan Tei (Tse) Chan, with whom he shared over 75 years of marriage.

Sin was naturalized as a U.S. citizen 15 years ago. He took great pride in being an American and true to his patriotism, fittingly passed away on the 4th of July. Prior to immigrating to the United States, Sin proudly served in the British Army of Hong Kong.

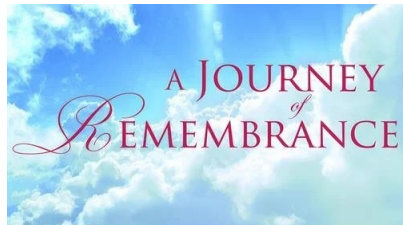

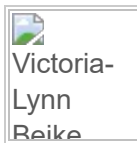

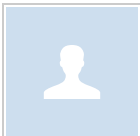
