Tim Beaudin, 63, resident of Hudson, NH, died on August 18, 2024, at the Southern NH Medical Center, Nashua, after a period of declining health.

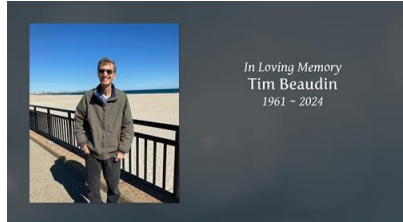
