A 2019 graduate of Pelham High School, Tyler was a kind, quiet soul that shared his smarts and wit with all who knew him. Currently in his junior year at WPI, Tyler was studying Electrical & Computer Engineering and was a member of the Men's Rowing team. In addition to Tyler's loving parents, he is survived by his younger sister, Avery Larson of Pelham, maternal grandparents Michael and Leona Ryan of Tewksbury, MA, paternal grandparents Jim and Barbara Larson of Portland, CT as well as many aunts, uncles and cousins.

Tyler was loved by so many, and he will be deeply missed, especially by his mother, dad, sister, and dog, Riley (Roo).

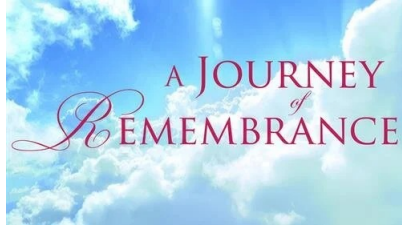

*Being his teacher for a few of his high school years gave me the opportunity to watch and experience Tyler's growth. When I first met Tyler in his freshman year, he was very quiet and it pained him to have to talk to me. However, he persevered and questioned and asked for guidance when he needed it. I saw that shy side of him, but appreciated him as I also had a quiet child.*

*Although Tyler was quiet, he was a leader and a gentle force. He always knew what he had to do and then some. I asked Tyler to pilot a math program which meant extra work for him. In his own manner, Tyler did the work necessary, but he went above and beyond writing a summary with the pros and cons even though it was after school was out for the summer. He was simply helping out.*

*Through the Robotics Team, Tyler shared that side of him that took responsibility to a new level. He helped with so many details other than the building of the robot such as taking attendance and journaling what the team had done. Tyler just did it without being asked, and his organizational skills helped his team.*

*By the time, junior and senior year came along Tyler's humor was evident in many ways. Mr. Gilcreast reminded me of the time he called me over to his class to watch Tyler dance with 3 of his classmates, and it was a silly dance! I was stunned standing there thinking what a difference a few years made. It was also during this time Tyler tried to charge me double for a candy bar that he bought from student government for a dollar. I picture his smile (smirk) looking up at me saying I have to make money somehow.*

*But I knew when Tyler gently reminded his mom that she was throwing Mrs. Caruso under the bus at a school board meeting which I attended and spoke of a math initiative that Tyler was looking out for me. It was my turn to smile as Tyler had my back.*

*Tyler was a wonderful, respectful, responsible, dependable, funny, quick-witted, shy young man who made my life richer knowing him. I am thankful to have had the opportunity to share in his high school journey.*

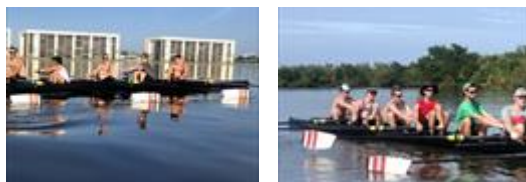
