Yvette B. Dion died Thursday, Aug. 25 at the Hillsborough County Nursing Home after a long period of declining health. She was born Nov. 23, 1923 in Drummondville, Quebec. Her family immigrated to Nashua, NH when she was 5 years old. She married Maurice Dion in June of 1942 and they lived in Hudson, NH, for 40 years, until Maurice's passing in 1991. Besides being a homemaker, she worked at Sprague Electric, then Sanders for several years. She came out of retirement to work at the Hudson Dairy Queen, and helped her son Richard with his painting and wallpapering company.

Family members include her son Ronald Dion and wife Irene, son David Dion and wife Charlotte, daughter Mary Ann Howe and husband David Howe, and daughter Denise Lecaroz and husband Allen. She was predeceased by her son Richard Dion, as well as her husband Maurice.
